This assessment enables us to identify, mitigate, and monitor any potential risks of modern slavery within our supply chain. By prioritising these efforts, we reaffirm our commitment to eradicating modern slavery and promoting ethical business practices throughout our operations.

Employee Training and Awareness

At Sentinel Marine, we prioritize equipping our employees with the knowledge and tools necessary to identify and combat modern slavery within our business operations. To achieve this, we conduct online training sessions with key personnel sourced externally, focusing specifically on modern slavery awareness and recognition.
